### General Guidelines

- Any life or annual member of IAPSM who are working in West Bengal are eligible for submission of abstract provided she/ he has registered for the conference after submitting requisite registration fees.
- One delegate can submit only one abstract.
- The abstract must be based on an original work or a systematic review/ meta-analysis.
- The results of study on which the abstract is prepared must not be presented in any conference/ workshop/ CME earlier, nor published or submitted elsewhere for publication.
- The abstract should be submitted by the principal investigator or the first author and only she/ he will be allowed to present in the conference, if selected. In exceptional situation, the organizing committee can permit other authors to present subject to submission of written No-objection certificate from the first and submitting author.
- The organizing committee reserves the right to select any number of abstract based on certain criteria and their decision stands final. If situation demands, the organizing committee reserves the right to cancel the session without any prior notice.
- The organizing committee reserves the right to publish the abstract in the souvenir commemorating this conference.
- The author(s) reserve(s) the right to publish it elsewhere after presentation with due mention about the presentation in the conference.

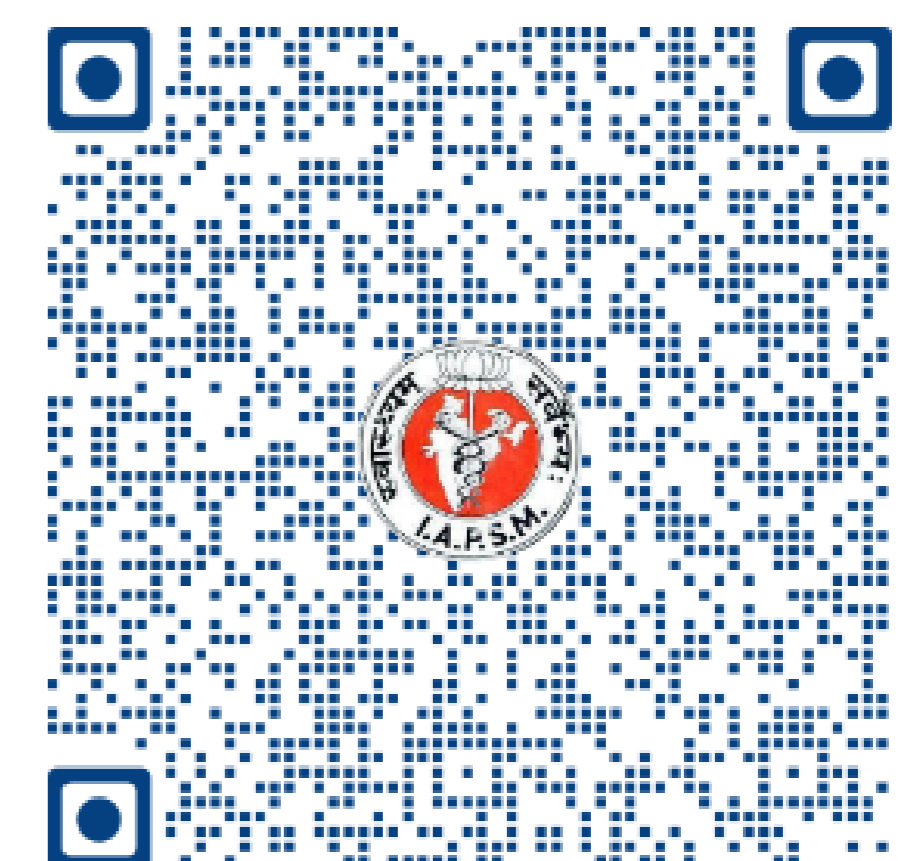
### Submission Guidelines

- The abstract must be structured under following sub-heading with the word limit of 300 words: a) Background b) Objective(s) c) Methods d) Results e) Conclusion f) Key words - 3-5.
- All abstracts must have a precise and meaningful title with word limit of 25 words. The title should not contain any abbreviation.
- The name(s) of the author(s) with their designation and affiliation must follow the title. The contact address including email id and phone number of the first and presenting author must be mentioned.
- The abstract must be submitted as the MS Word document, typed in Times New Roman font with font size 14. The title may be made bold, but, must not be formatted as All CAPS.
- The preference for oral/ poster presentation must be mentioned during submission.
- All abstracts are to be submitted latest by 15th July 2024 through the below mentioned link. Submission through other mode will not be entertained.
